

Shipping and Receiving Policies

The Delta Bessborough would be pleased to accept the delivery of your conference materials. We ask that you follow these guidelines to assist us in better serving you:

Please address all packages in the following manner:

Delta Bessborough -- Shipping/Receiving Department c/o your company (or convention), on-site contact, date of function 601 Spadina Crescent East Saskatoon, Saskatchewan S7K 3G8

- 2) Packages should be labelled 1 of 3, 2 of 3, etc.
- 3) As storage space is limited, packages should be sent to arrive no earlier than two days prior to your event, and picked up no later than two days after your event.

Hub City Display can co-ordinate drayage services (a "materials handling service") which includes receiving of all display materials, delivery of these materials to the individual display booth, display booth draperies, additional electrical requirements, and packing and shipping of all displays after the event. - 4) Packages arriving from other countries will be required to clear through the Federal Government Customs and Excise Offices. The Delta Bessborough recommends the use of a Customs Brokerage firm to expedite your delivery.
